Registration Scholarship Request Procedures

If a parent needs assistance with registration fees, TCAA has a scholarship program that provides: a) a full scholarship that covers the registration fees; b) a partial scholarship that covers a portion of the registration fees; and c) assistance with uniform purchases for the recreational softball program that are required to participate in team games.

Eligibility Requirements

A parent seeking a scholarship must explain in writing the nature of the hardship and/or provide supporting documentation upon request of the league. To be eligible for a scholarship, the following information must be supplied to TCAA:

1. A completed Scholarship Request Form.
2. A completed registration packet for each player using the scholarship.
3. A completed Volunteer Form for the parent/guardian seeking the scholarship.

How to Apply for a Scholarship

1. Parent/guardian completes a Scholarship Request Form and submits it to TCAA.
2. The request is reviewed by the TCAA Board at the next regularly scheduled board meeting.
3. The parent is notified of the Board's decision within a week of the board meeting.

Terms and Conditions

If the scholarship is approved, the following terms and conditions will apply:

- The scholarship covers only the one season that is requested. Scholarships are available for either Spring or Fall season. Summer season is not included.
- The parent/guardian agrees to volunteer for TCAA league functions and activities as a means of "repayment". Example league functions and activities include coaching, fundraising, working concessions, being a Team Parent, and volunteering during the Babe Ruth World Series in the summer.
- The player(s) must meet all registration requirements for the season.
- A registration packet must be completed for the player(s).
